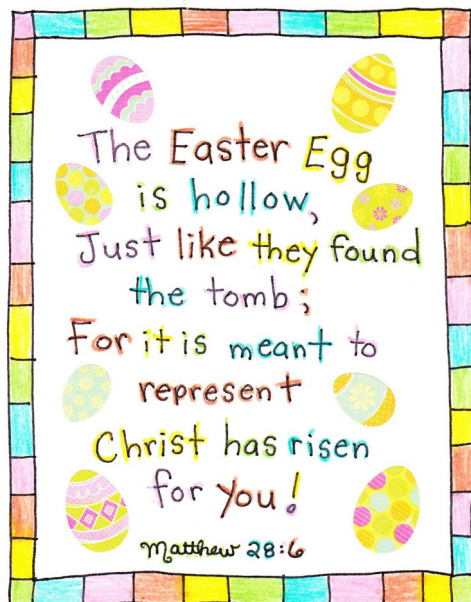

KITCHEN: If you are eating prepared foods from our kitchen, know that, at times, our kitchen uses SOME of the following items, but not limited to: Milk, eggs, nuts, peanuts, seafood, shellfish (shrimp, lobster, etc.), soybeans, wheat products. Note: these may be also an ingredient in the packaged foods.



FAMILY FOOD BOX PROGRAM

A person, with a residence that has an **APPROVED APPLICATION**, may be eligible for a **FREE** food box each month. **Food boxes can be reserved over the phone but ONLY by talking with a live operator.** (No phone messages will be returned, or boxes ordered from a message.) However, you can sign up **ONLINE** and avoid making phone calls.

If delivered to your home, an adult must be present to receive the FAMILY FOOD BOX. If no adult is present, or you are not home to receive the FAMILY FOOD BOX the box will be forfeited for 30 days. One FAMILY FOOD BOX per address.

The best way to understand the real meaning of Easter would be from Jesus, in His three words ... **the new covenant**.



The New Covenant In Luke 22 we get a picture of the night before his death:

When the time came, Jesus and the apostles sat down together at the table. Jesus said, "I have been very eager to eat this Passover meal with you before my suffering begins. For I tell you now that I won't eat this meal again until its meaning is fulfilled in the Kingdom of God." Then he took a cup of wine and gave thanks to God for it. Then he said, "Take this and share it among yourselves. For I will not drink wine again until the Kingdom of God has come." He took some bread and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and gave it to the disciples, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me." After supper he took another cup of wine and said, "This cup is the new covenant between God and his people—an agreement confirmed with my blood, which is poured out as a sacrifice for you."
